Application Note

*Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the researcher.

Suggested dilution	Recommended dilution
IHC-P	1:20–1:40
IHC-Fr	1:20–1:40

Note : High temperature antigen retrieval using 0.01 M citrate retrieval solution (pH 6.0) is recommended.

The recommended fixative is 10% neutral-buffered formalin for paraffin-embedded tissue sections. This antibody requires the sections to be fixed in acetone/methanol at a ratio of 1:1 for 4 minutes at 25°C prior to incubation with the primary antibody.

Not tested in other applications.

Product Note Reactive with the dysferlin molecule in human skeletal muscle. Also present in many non-muscle tissues.

Buffer	Tissue culture supernatant
Preservative	0.09% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Immunogen	Synthetic peptide containing amino acids 349-366, spanning exons 11 and 12, of the human dysferlin molecule.
Purification	Unpurified
Conjugation	Unconjugated
