### Application Note

\*Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the researcher.

Suggested dilution	Recommended dilution
IHC-P	1-2 µg/ml
<b>Note : Staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires heating tissue sections in 10mM Tris buffer with 1mM EDTA (pH 9.0) for 45 min at 95°C followed by cooling at RT for 20 minutes.</b>

<b>Form</b>	Liquid
<b>Buffer</b>	PBS, 0.05% BSA
<b>Preservative</b>	0.05% Sodium azide
<b>Storage</b>	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. Store at 4°C.
<b>Concentration</b>	200 µg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
<b>Immunogen</b>	Recombinant fragment of extracellular domain of human Insulin Receptor alpha
<b>Purification</b>	Protein A/G purified
<b>Conjugation</b>	Unconjugated

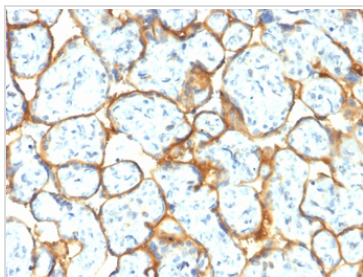
