Buffer	PBS, 20% Glycerol
Preservative	0.025% ProClin 300
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	1.68 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Recombinant protein encompassing a sequence within the Intracellular domain of human IL10 Receptor alpha. The exact sequence is proprietary.
Purification	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography.

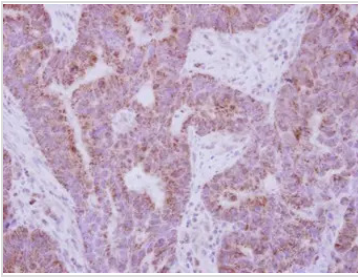
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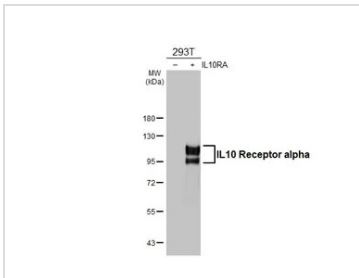

Non-transfected (–) and transfected (+) 293T whole cell extracts (30 µg) were separated by 7.5% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with IL10 Receptor alpha antibody (GTX102731) diluted at 1:5000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody (GTX213110-01) was used to detect the primary antibody.



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
