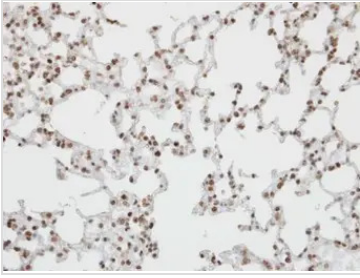

<b>Form</b>	Liquid
<b>Buffer</b>	PBS, 10% Glycerol
<b>Preservative</b>	0.01% Thimerosal
<b>Storage</b>	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Concentration</b>	1 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
<b>Immunogen</b>	Carrier-protein conjugated synthetic peptide encompassing a sequence within the C-terminus region of human Pokemon. The exact sequence is proprietary.
<b>Purification</b>	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography.
<b>Conjugation</b>	Unconjugated

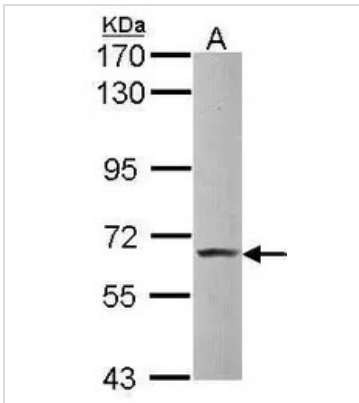
