Buffer	0.1M Tris, 0.1M Glycine, 20% Glycerol
Preservative	0.01% Thimerosal
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	1 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Recombinant protein encompassing a sequence within the center region of human ADHFE1. The exact sequence is proprietary.
Purification	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography.
Conjugation	Unconjugated

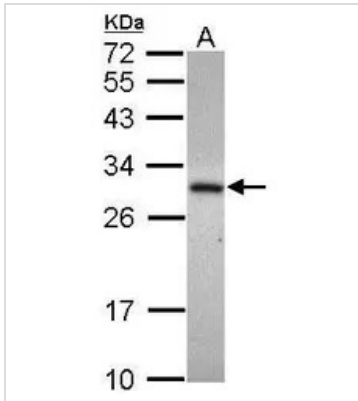
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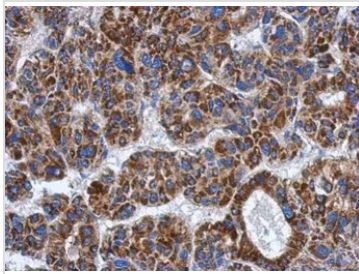

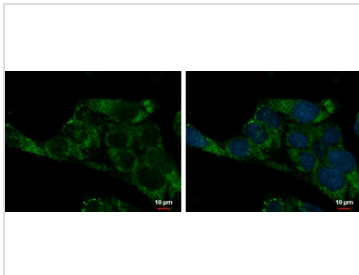
GTx119264 WB Image
