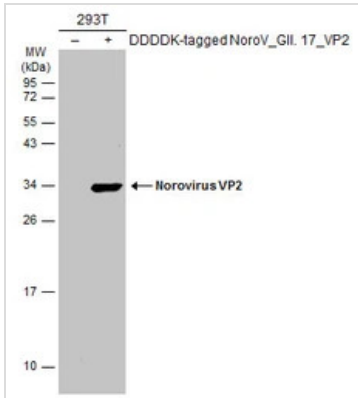
## Properties

<b>Form</b>	Liquid
<b>Buffer</b>	PBS, 20% Glycerol
<b>Preservative</b>	0.025% ProClin 300
<b>Storage</b>	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Concentration</b>	0.57 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
<b>Immunogen</b>	Recombinant protein encompassing a sequence within the center region of Norovirus VP2 ( GII.17 ) (Norovirus (Hu/GII/CN/2014/GII.17/1401169)). The exact sequence is proprietary.
<b>Purification</b>	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography.
<b>Conjugation</b>	Unconjugated

### GTX134386 WB Image

Non-transfected (–) and transfected (+) 293T whole cell extracts (30 µg) were separated by 12% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with Norovirus VP2 antibody (GTX134386) diluted at 1:5000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody (GTX213110-01) was used to detect the primary antibody.



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
