

Preservative	0.025% ProClin 300
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, we recommend adding 50% glycerol, then aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	1.08 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Recombinant protein encompassing a sequence within the center region of Lassa virus Nucleoprotein (Lassa virus (strain mouse/Sierra Leone/Josiah/1976)). The exact sequence is proprietary.

Non-transfected (-) and transfected (+) 293T whole cell extracts (30 µg) were separated by 7.5% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with Lassa virus Nucleoprotein antibody (GTX134884) diluted at 1:5000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody (GTX213110-01) was used to detect the primary antibody.
