<b>Form</b>	Liquid
<b>Buffer</b>	PBS, 50% Glycerol
<b>Preservative</b>	0.02% Sodium azide
<b>Storage</b>	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Concentration</b>	Batch dependent (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
<b>Immunogen</b>	Recombinant fusion protein containing a sequence corresponding to amino acids 1-152 of human UBE2B (NP_003328.1).
<b>Purification</b>	Purified by affinity chromatography
<b>Conjugation</b>	Unconjugated

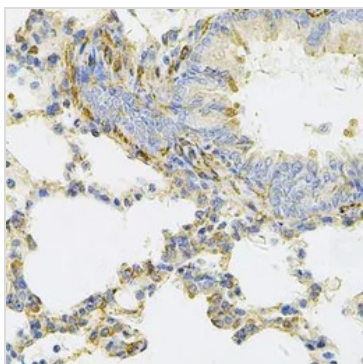

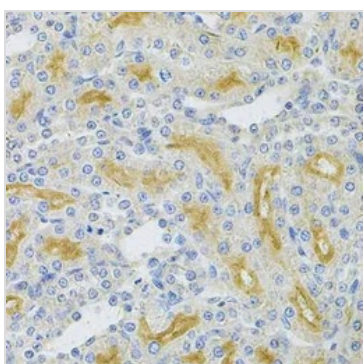

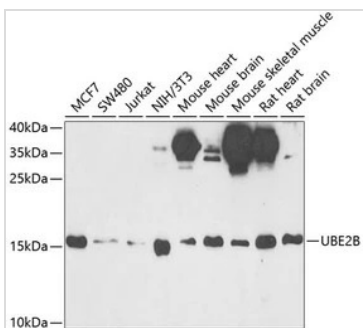
**GTX16443 IHC-P Image**
