Product Note At least two isoforms of ADRM1 are known to exist; this antibody will detect both isoforms.

Form	Liquid
Buffer	PBS
Preservative	0.02% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	1 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	ADRM1 antibody was raised against a 19 amino acid peptide near the center of human ADRM1. The immunogen is located within amino acids 210 - 260 of ADRM1.
Purification	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography
Conjugation	Unconjugated



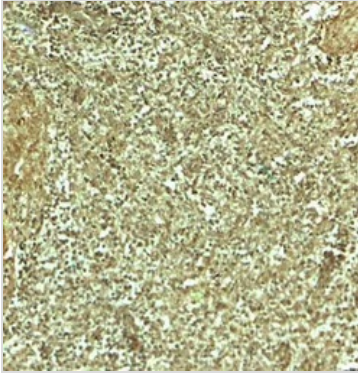

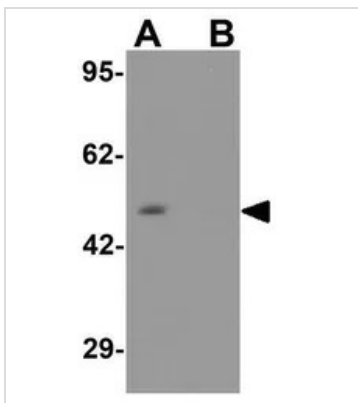
