Some tissue types may require extra attention as they may contain high levels of endogenous biotin, peroxidase, or autofluorescence.
	GeneTexis single tissue slides contain 4 μ m sections of formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded human tissue (1-2 cm x 1-2 cm) affixed to Snowcoat X-tra (Surgipath) slides. Tissue diagnosis was performed by certified pathologists.

GeneTex'Shuman tissue slides can be used with any antibody shown to be effective in formalin-fixed tissue using a standard immunostaining protocol. In order to avoid false negative results from DNA or RNA sequences not being present in a 4 µm cellular cross-section, 10 µm tissue sections are recommended. 10 μm single tissue slides are available upon request. This product has not been evaluated for effectiveness in ISH or FISH applications.
