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Product Note This antibody reacts predominantly with phosphorylated SOX 9. The antibodies were evaluated for specificity with a dot blot assay using synthetically prepared SOX 9 peptides. It only recognizes the phosphorylated serine 181 of human SOX 9, not other phosphorylated sites or non-phosphorylated SOX 9.

Form	Liquid
Buffer	PBS, 0.1% BSA
Preservative	0.05% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	0.2 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Synthetic peptide (QPRRRKpSVKNG) corresponding to human / mouse / bovine SOX 9 at the phosphorylation site of Serine 181.
Purification	Immunogen affinity purified
Conjugation	Unconjugated

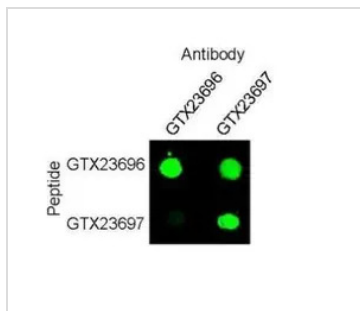

GTX23696 Dot Image

Dot blot analysis of the SOX-9 peptide (pSer181) and SOX-9 peptide probed with the anti-SOX-9 (pSer181) (GTX23696) and anti-SOX-9 (GTX23697).

The staining shows that the anti-SOX-9 (pSer181) recognized the SOX-9 peptide (pSer181) only; whole the anti-SOX-9 could bind both the SOX-9 peptide (pSer181) and SOX-9 peptide.



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
