Summary

Human ureter tissue membrane protein lysate was prepared by isolating the membrane protein from whole tissue homogenates using a proprietary technique. The human ureter tissue was frozen in liquid nitrogen immediately after excision and then stored at -70°C. For quality control purposes, the isolated ureter tissue membrane protein pattern on SDS-PAGE gel is shown to be consistent for each lot by visualization with coomassie blue staining.

Storage Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. Aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
