Summary	Human tonsil tissue membrane protein lysate was prepared by isolating the membrane protein from whole tissue homogenates using a proprietary technique. The human tonsil tissue was frozen in liquid nitrogen immediately after excision and then stored at -70°C. For quality control purposes, the isolated tonsil tissue membrane protein pattern on SDS-PAGE gel is shown to be consistent for each lot by visualization with coomassie blue staining.

Buffer	HEPES, MgCl ₂ , KCl, EDTA, Sodium deoxycholate, Sucrose, NP-40, Glycerol, a cocktail of protease inhibitors
