Summary	Human gallbladder tissue membrane protein lysate was prepared by isolating the membrane protein from whole tissue homogenates using a proprietary technique. The human gallbladde tissue was frozen in liquid nitrogen immediately after excision and then stored at -70°C. For quality control purposes, the isolated gallbladde tissue membrane protein pattern on SDS-PAGE gel is shown to be consistent for each lot by visualization with coomassie blue staining.
