Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	1 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Rheb antibody was raised against a 15 amino acid synthetic peptide from the middle region of human Rheb. The immunogen is located within amino acids 40 - 90 of Rheb.
Purification	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography
Conjugation	Unconjugated

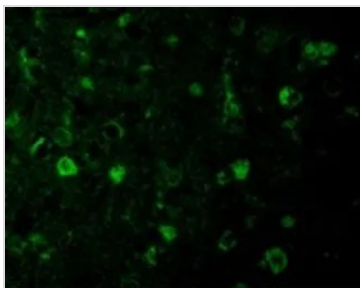

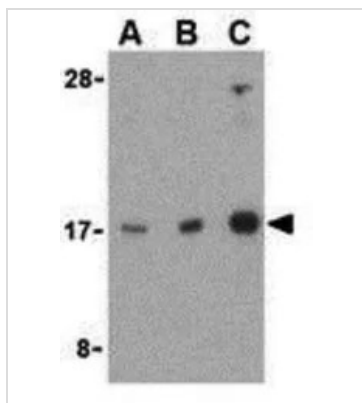

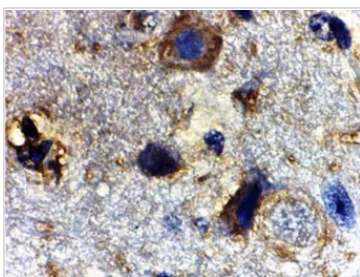
