Form	Liquid
Buffer	PBS, 50% Glycerol
Preservative	0.02% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	Batch dependent (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Recombinant fusion protein containing a sequence corresponding to amino acids 177-326 of human DNAJB6 (NP_490647.1).
Purification	Purified by affinity chromatography
Conjugation	Unconjugated

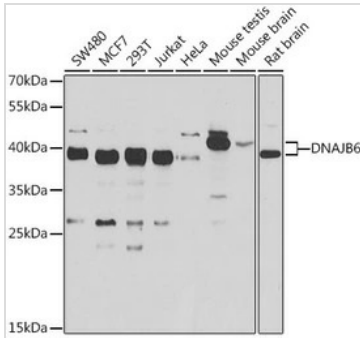

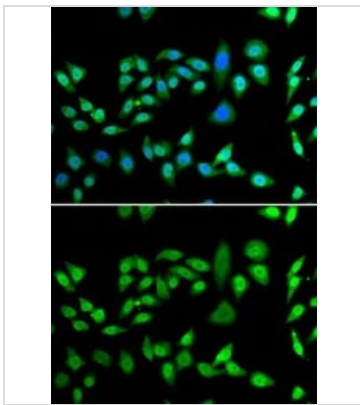


GTX33160 WB Image

Dilution : 1:1000

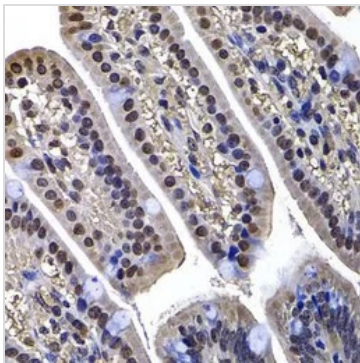
Loading : 25µg per lane

ICC/IF analysis of U2OS cells using GTX33160 DNAJB6 antibody.

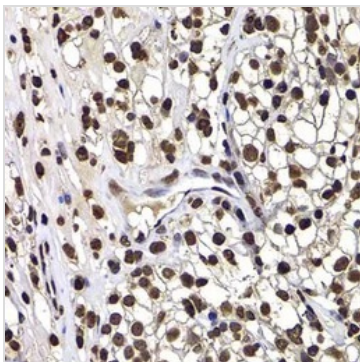
Blue : DAPI
