*Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the researcher.

Suggested dilution	Recommended dilution
WB	1-2µg/ml
ICC/IF	1-2µg/ml
IHC-P	1-2µg/ml for 30 minutes at RT
FCM	1-2µg/10 ⁶ cells

Note : Staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires heating tissue sections in 10mM Tris with 1mM EDTA, pH 9.0, for 45 min at 95°C followed by cooling at RT for 20 minutes.

Not tested in other applications.

Form	Liquid
Buffer	PBS, 0.05% BSA
Preservative	0.05% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	0.2 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Recombinant human Galectin-13 protein fragment (aa23-134)
Purification	Protein A/G purified
Conjugation	Unconjugated



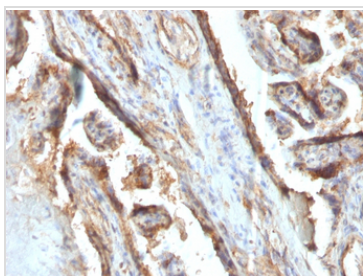

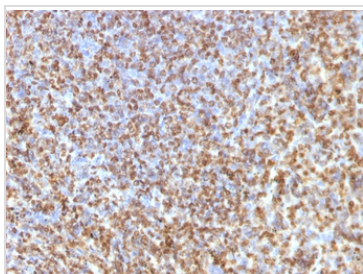

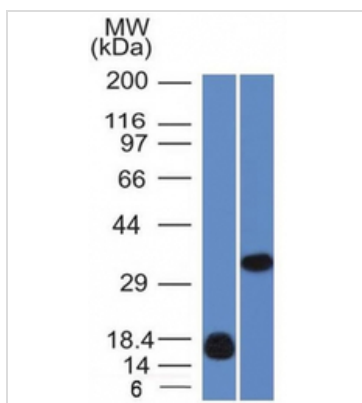
