Suggested dilution	Recommended dilution
ICC/IF	1-2µg/ml
IHC-P	1-2µg/ml for 30 minutes at RT
FCM	1-2µg/10 ⁶ cells

Product Note	Reacts with a 70kDa membrane-bound isozyme (Regan and Nagao type) of Placental Alkaline Phosphatase (PLAP) occurring in the placenta during the 3rd trimester of gestation. It is highly specific for PLAP and shows no cross-reaction with other isozymes of alkaline phosphatase.

Form	Liquid
Buffer	PBS, 0.05% BSA
Preservative	0.05% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	0.2 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Recombinant full-length human ALPP protein
Purification	Protein A/G purified
Conjugation	Unconjugated




