Buffer	20mM Potassium Phosphate, 150mM NaCl

Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.



Western blot using GeneTex's protein-A purified Anti-MIP-1 beta (CCL4) antibody shows detection of recombinant pig MIP-1 beta (CCL4) raised in yeast. The protein was purified and resolved by SDS-PAGE, then transferred to PVDF membrane. Membrane was blocked with 3% BSA , and probed with 4 $\mu g/mL$ primary antibody overnight at 4°C. After washing, membrane was probed with IRDye800 Conjugated Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:20,000 for 45 min at room temperature.
