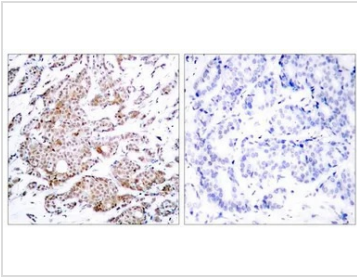

Buffer	PBS, 150mM NaCl, 50% Glycerol
Preservative	0.02% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	1 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Peptide sequence around phosphorylation site of threonine 58 (L-P-T(p)-P-P) derived from human c-Myc.

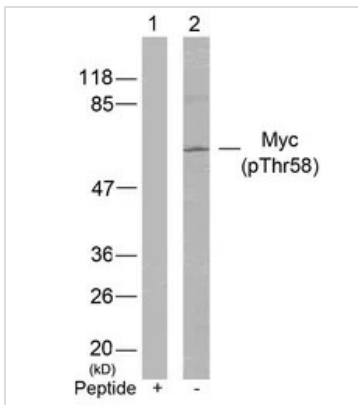
