Immunogen	Synthetic peptide encompassing a sequence within the Extracellular domain of human IL2 Receptor alpha. The exact sequence is proprietary.

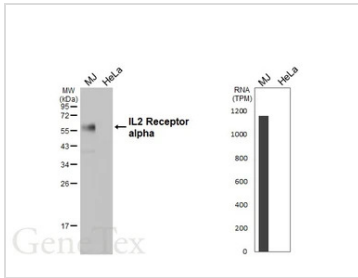

Various whole cell extracts (30 µg) were separated by 12% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with IL2 Receptor alpha antibody [HL6029] (GTX648103) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody (GTX213110-01) was used to detect the primary antibody. Corresponding RNA expression data are based on Human Protein Atlas program.



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
