Buffer	PBS, 150mM NaCl, 0.5% BSA, 50% glycerol (Please contact us for BSA-free format)
Preservative	0.02% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	Batch dependent (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	The antiserum was produced against synthesized phosphopeptide derived from human P53 around the phosphorylation site of serine 20 (T-F-Sp-D-L).
Purification	Purified by sequential chromatography on phospho- and non-phospho-peptide affinity columns. From serum

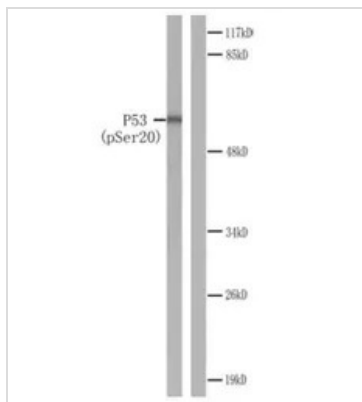

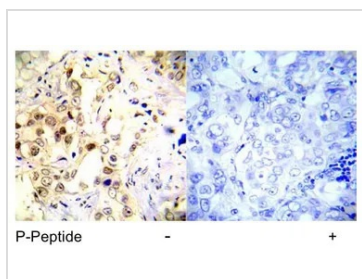


GTx78985 WB Image
