Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	1 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	LYRM3 antibody was raised against a 17 amino acid synthetic peptide near the carboxy terminus of human LYRM3. The immunogen is located within the last 50 amino acids of LYRM3.
Purification	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography

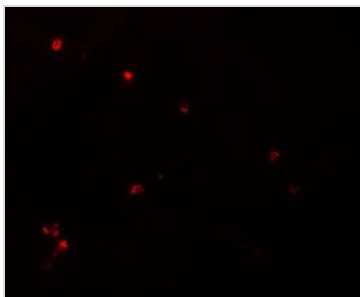
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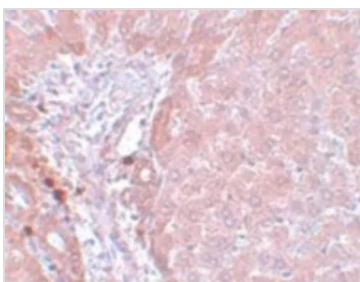

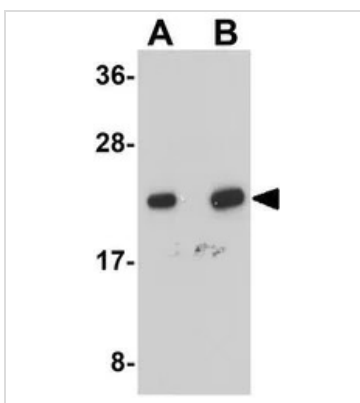
GTX85007 IHC-P Image
