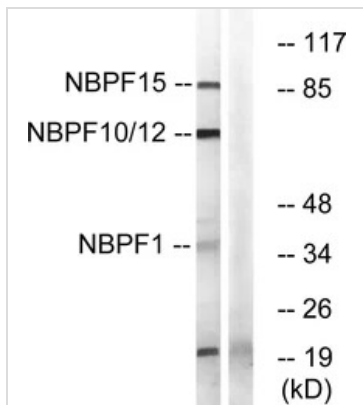
## Properties

<b>Form</b>	Liquid
<b>Buffer</b>	PBS, 150mM NaCl, 50% Glycerol
<b>Preservative</b>	0.02% Sodium azide
<b>Storage</b>	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Concentration</b>	Batch dependent (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
<b>Immunogen</b>	The antiserum was produced against synthesized peptide derived from human NBPF1/9/10/12/14/15/16/20 (121-150).
<b>Purification</b>	Purified by antigen-affinity chromatography From serum
