Buffer	TBS, 0.5% BSA
Preservative	0.02% Sodium azide
Storage	Store as concentrated solution. Centrifuge briefly prior to opening vial. For short-term storage (1-2 weeks), store at 4°C. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Concentration	0.50 mg/ml (Please refer to the vial label for the specific concentration.)
Immunogen	Peptide with sequence C-KDFLQSLKGFPRGDK, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_000925.2; NP_001159393.1.
Purification	Purified by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography

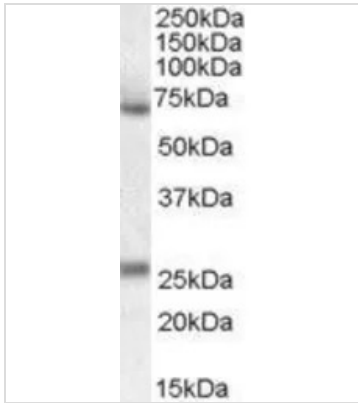

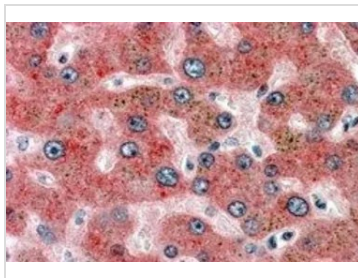


GTX88657 WB Image
